
**ACTION ITEM:** Request for Differential Tuition Increase for the Master of Business Administration (MBA), Master of Science in Accounting (MSA), and Master of Science in Information Technology and Management (MSITM) for 2012-13.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

- The President and Board of Governors have provided the UNC campuses an opportunity to propose increases in differential tuition rates for professional graduate programs.
- As described in the enclosed statement of request, Master of Business Administration (MBA), Master of Science in Accounting (MSA) and Master of Science in Information Technology and Management (MSITM) propose to raise the differential tuition from its current level of \$120/sch to \$160/sch for 2012-13. As indicated in the enclosure, current plans contemplate an additional increase to \$200/sch in 2013-14, representing a total increase of \$80/sch phased in over two academic years. All programs consulted with their respective student bodies before making the recommendation.
- The present request is for the 2012-13 academic year only. Chancellor Brady has endorsed this request. If approved by the Board of Trustees, the proposal will be submitted to the Board of Governors for approval.

**RECOMMENDED ACTION:**

That the Board of Trustees of The University of North Carolina at Greensboro approve the 2012-13 differential tuition rate proposed for the Master of Business Administration, Master of Science in Accounting, and Master of Science in Information Technology and Management programs.
